<b>Content:</b>	This is an Allied Translator and Interpreter Section (ATIS) interrogation report for 1st Class Private JA145633 of the 51st Division 115th Infantry Regiment 3rd Battalion 12th Company 1st Platoon 3rd Section, who surrendered in Baiduang on 23 October 1943. JA145633, a 26 year old 1st Class Private from Gunma, could not keep up with the rest due to malaria and diarrhoea and was wandering in the jungle when he was captured by Australian troops. He was a rifleman in his unit. During the interrogation, JA145633 provided information on his unit organisation, movements, morale and propaganda.
